FARMER 4.0: CALL FOR COMPETITION

The social part of the project promotes the exchange of knowledge and the sharing of innovative ideas.

In this sense, a competition of ideas has been held within the Farmers' Community, and the project's stakeholders. During the Multipliers Events the first ideas contest has been launched, with the aim of stimulating creativity and the exchange of innovative ideas. The specific requirements of the contest were published through a call for proposals and disseminated through the main communication channels of the project (website, facebook, newsletter, etc.). A committee of experts will decide on the best entrepreneurship for the project in each partner country.

CALL FOR COMPETITION IN SPAIN: A total of 25 students from the EFA MALVESIA training center participated in the competition by submitting 3 projects:

- Agropocket: designing a mobile app to deal agrarian exploitation.
- Chainsaw with Sharpener Included
- Mycorrhizae: Microcaps.

The winning project was a chainsaw with a sharpener included.



CALL FOR COMPETITION IN FRANCE: the competition received 23 applications from teams of 2 to 6 people, seizing the opportunity of a national competition "Sustainable Agriculture and Food", linking digital to the theme. The winner will be chosen at the end of January.

CONCERTATION TABLES



One of the various activities of dissemination and monitoring of the project has been the consultation tables. These actions have been carried out among the partners of the project, teachers, political leaders and social and economic agents more representative of each territory. Three consultation meetings have been held in the different partner countries.

In the case of Spain, 2 activities were carried out in person and one online. During the first one, a presentation of the project was made and the skills and competencies and level of knowledge that farmers must have in order to work with 4.0 technology were analyzed.

In the second call, synergies were established among the participants for the development, implementation and sustainability of the Farmer 4.0 project.

In the third table of consultation, the action plan for the agricultural sector in the region was worked on and validated, including the actions carried out under the Farmer 4.0 project.

VIRTUAL MEETINGS

During the continuation of the project, several virtual meetings have taken place, given the impossibility of travelling due to the situation generated by the global pandemic. A total of 3 virtual meetings have been held. The content of these has been to organize the different activities of the project adapting them to the new deadlines. The partners discussed the development of the different deliverable of the project and prepared a detailed plan with the next activities and next steps. The virtual meetings were the following: 13th July, 21st September and 9th November.




BETA TESTING
